This Saturday, July 13th, Middlesex find themselves in the unusual position of defending the league lead as they head to Reading BC to face the Royal County of Berkshire BA.

The big victory, last time out, against Buckinghamshire propelled Middlesex to the top of the table and a commanding 2 point lead over Surrey. Berkshire, themselves, are within touching distance of the top, only 8 points adrift in 4th but they have already played 4 games against Middlesex's 3.
